

BARRY HASKINS' FLEABANE TRIAL

Fleabane control following harvest will again be vital for good fallow management and high water use efficiencies.

This trial compares most commercial brews that would be used on fleabane in fallows, with and without various double knock treatments. There are some stand outs that are worth seeing, and this is a great opportunity to see it all side by side. There is also the new 2,4-D Amine 700 formulation from Nufarm in the trial, and possibly will have a strip to look at Roundup Attack and Sharpen (two new products from Nufarm). This will depend on permits.

DETAILS

Where: "Melbergen" Monia Gap Rd. See map below. Once on farm go past house and sheds and enter laneway towards the Hill (in between house and sheds). Turn right after 1km, and the trial is in the fallow paddock ahead.

When: Friday 2nd December, 2012.

Time: 9am sharp (will finish around 11am).
